EMERGENCY PROCEDURES **FIRE SERVICE & AMBULANCE: DIAL 111**
NATIONAL POISONS CENTRE: 0800 764 766 (0800 POISON)

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Vehicle accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	Wear suitable protective clothing. Restrict access to contaminated area. Contain the spill and prevent further dispersion. Retrieve intact containers and capsules from site. Place damaged containers and capsules into containment devices. Absorb spills with inert material and place in waste containers. Wash the area with water and absorb with further inert material. Collect spilled material and place in sealable containers for subsequent disposal. Avoid contamination of water courses or sewers. Dispose of waste safely.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Non flammable and non combustible so treat the fire as for the other materials present. Do not allow water to enter drains. For fire-fighting wear breathing apparatus (smoke containing decomposition products may be a hazard to health).

FIRST AID

If swallowed	If swallowed Seek medical attention. Do NOT induce vomiting.
If in eyes	If splashed in eyes wash out immediately with water.
If on skin	If skin or hair contact occurs remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water.
If inhaled	Remove patient to fresh air.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

Storage: Store below 30°C (room temperature). Store in original packaging in a dry place. Protect from light. After opening, ensure aluminium foil bags are re-sealed properly to protect capsules. Keep out of reach of children.

Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
